Many lives have been saved throughout the world by boaters who did the responsible thing and wore a life jacket. Be sure it's U.S. Coast Guard-approved and appropriate for the activity.

Have the Right Life Jacket?

- -Check the label printed on the inside of the life jacket to identify that it is appropriate for your water activity.
- -Snug fit and fastened.
- -You don't want your life jacket too large or too small
- -Inflatable life jackets only for those 16 years and older, strong swimmers

Life Jacket Care

- -Use properly
- -No rips, waterlogging or mildew
- -Dry after use
- -Hand wash in warm, soapy water
- -Store in a dry place when not boating

Inflatable Life Jacket Care

- -Test: Orally inflate & holds air for 16-24 hours
- Inspect cartridge (insure it is not discharged & no corrosion)
 If it holds air, repack & use
