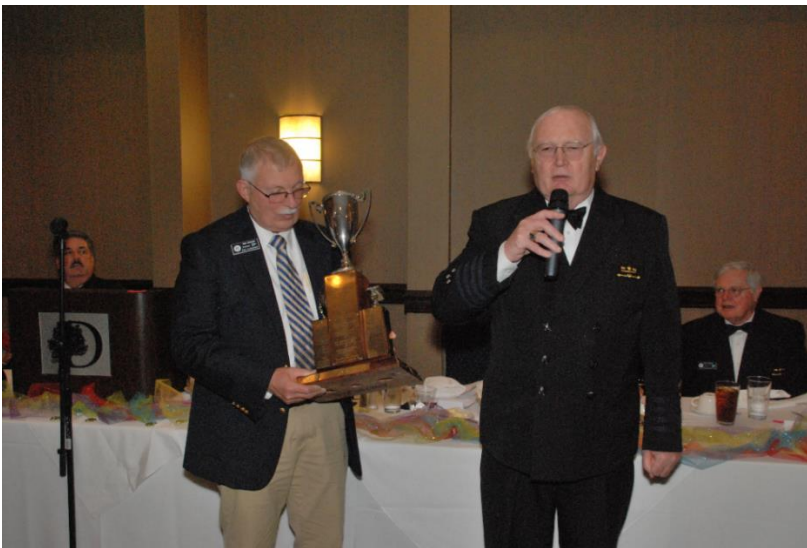
For news that can't wait!

- USPS Educational Fund Certificate of Merit - 14th Award

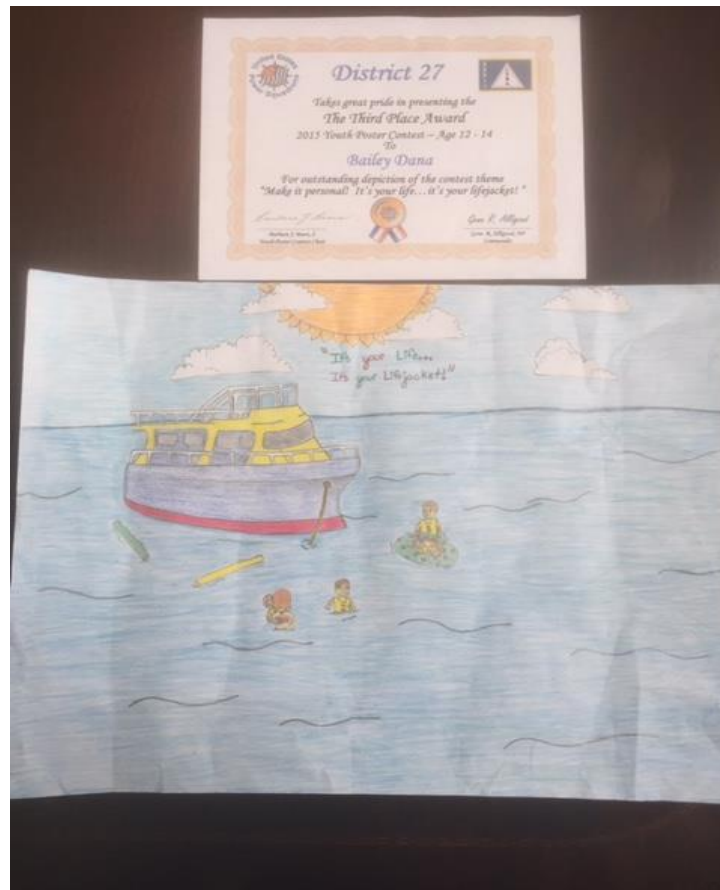
