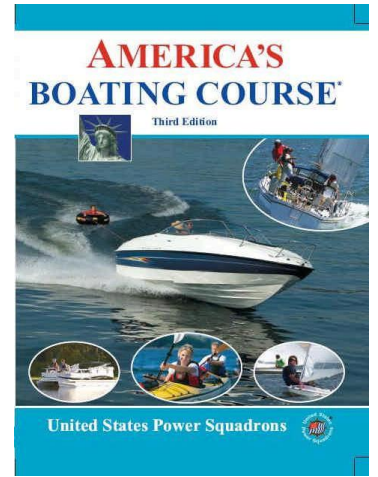

In North Carolina all persons born on or after January 1, 1988 are required to take a NASBLA approved training course to operate any watercraft with a 10 HP or greater. Completion of this course meets that requirement.
